The Future Simple Tense (Будущее простое время)

Для времени the Future Simple характерно употребление следующих наречий:

- tomorrow 3aBTpa She will read this book tomorrow
- in a year через год I will go to school in a year
- in two days через два дня They will watch TV in two days
- next week на следующей неделе We will visit this place next week

I will (work)	I will not (work)
He will (work)	He will not (work)
she will (work)	she will not (work)
It will(work)	It will not (work)
We will (work)	We will not (work)
You will (work)	You will not (work)
They will (work)	They will not (work)

They will not (work)	Yes, I will	No, I will not
They will not (work)	Yes, he will	No, he will not
Will she (work)?	Yes, she will	No, she will not
