

Future Simple: Forms

will + V1

- · I will help you.
- She will call me when I arrive.

be going to + V1

- He is going to spend his vacation in London.
- · I'm going to be an actor when I grow up.

Use

We use the future simple:

for future actions which may or may not happen.



We'll visit Disney World one day.

- for predictions about the future. Life will be better fifty years from now.
- for threats or warnings.



Stop or I'll shoot.


for promises or on-the-spot decisions.



I'll help you with your homework.
